

# FREE GDPR For Magento 2

## Overview

We believe everything that is necessary should be FREE. To support your GDPR needs, we have come up with FREE GDPR extension.

GDPR extension provides consent check boxes that your site users will use to opt-in to your website, and space for you to add necessary information. Make sure each consent field accurately describes your purpose for fetching the information on site and any marketing activities.

The extension will provide a few common purposes for a form and marketing activities to choose from, and you can also add your own. Remember that each marketing activity must be clearly communicated and requires separate consent.

## All it takes is just 5 minutes for this simple setup:

1. Download and install this extension.
2. Go To Stores >> Configuration >> Magenticity >> GDPR and do required setup.

## Features

1. GDPR compliant consent on your website form.
2. Ability to show consents on Register page, contact page and checkout page.
3. Easily to change consent title.
4. Facility to add up to 5 consents.
5. Enable/Disable extension from back-end.
6. Enable/Disable Cookie Restriction Mode.
7. Admin has full control over the content to be displayed within the GDPR fields.

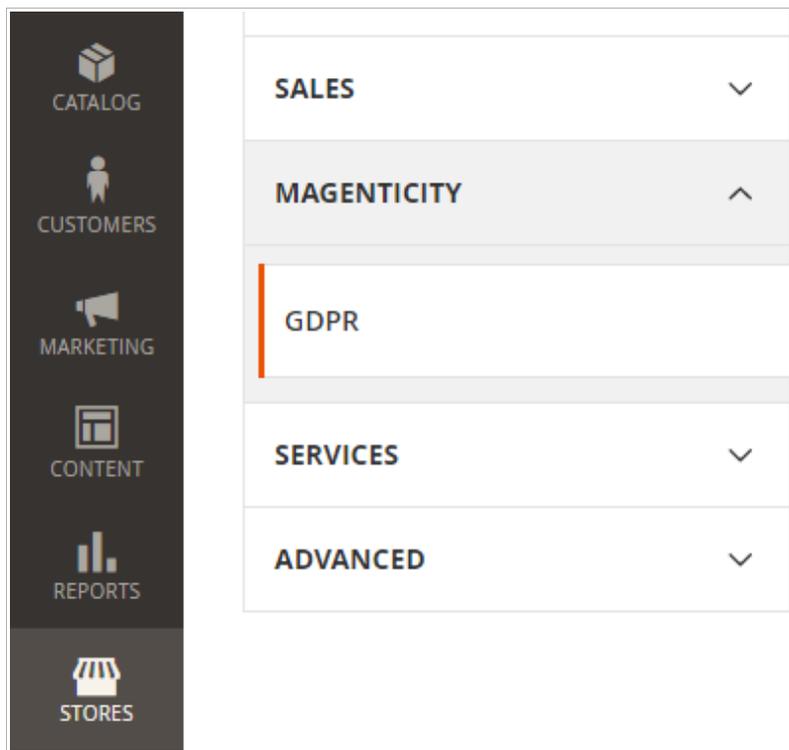
## Install extension using COMMAND LINE

1. Download the GDPR extension from the My Account section.
2. Unzip the file in a temporary directory/folder with name as Gdpr.
3. Put GRDP directory as per this folder structure:: project\_root/app/code/Magenticity/Gdpr
4. Disable Cache from the **System >> Cache Management**.
5. Give proper file permission.
6. Enter below command line in your magento\_store\_root:  
**php bin/magento setup:upgrade**
7. Enter below command line in your magento\_store\_root to compile the code  
**php -dmemory\_limit=1g bin/magento setup:di:compile.**

8. Give proper file permission.
9. Enter below command line in your magento\_store\_root to generate static files into your pub directory.  
**php -dmemory\_limit=1g bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy**
10. Give proper file permission.
11. Enable/Refresh cache from **System >> Cache Management**.
12. After following all above steps, you will see this module (Magenticity\_Gdpr) at **Stores >> Configuration >> Advanced >> Advanced**, the extension will be shown in the admin panel.

## How To Use?

1. Login into your Magento Back-end / Admin Panel.
2. Go To **Stores >> Configuration >> Magenticity >> GDPR**.



3. To enable/disable GDPR extension **Go To Stores >> Configuration >> Magenticity >> GDPR >> General >> Consents Enable**.
4. To Display custom message on Privacy setting page (under My Account) **Go To Stores >> Configuration >> Magenticity >> GDPR >> General >> Consents message on My account page**.

5. To display consents on form

6. To enable/disable consent, change consent title and consent required **Go To Stores >> Configuration >> Magenticity >> GDPR >> Consents Boxes.**
